Program Overview:

The George Biddle Kelley Education Foundation is the charitable arm of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., Beta Pi Lambda Chapter. The foundation was created under the principles of providing service and advocacy for communities in the Capital District. Scholarship, and love for all mankind are the seeds of our "Go To High School, Go To College" program, which supports this scholarship. Developed in the 1950's, the George Biddle Kelley Scholarship aims to award and acknowledge financially disadvantaged and underserved students from the Capital District, who are committed to the values of scholarship, and improving the lives of others in the community.

Available Scholarships: Applicants may apply for the general scholarship and up to two additional specific awards:

- George Biddle Kelley General Scholarship
- Elmer L. Green Scholarship for the Physical Sciences (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, etc.)
- Leon C. Nelson Scholarship for the Social Sciences (Sociology, Economics, Political Science, History, etc.)

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements: To be eligible for this scholarship, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a male from a traditionally underrepresented community in the Capital District
- Be a current candidate for graduation from an accredited public or private high school in the Capital District
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (or 83 average)
- Have applied to, and/or been accepted into, a degree program at an accredited four-year college or university
- Submit a completed application – **All participants must complete the General Scholarship Application (Part I)**

Applications will be considered based on the following: documented financial need, live and work in diverse environments, exceptional leadership skills, scholarship and a commitment to community service.

Application Process:

Submission of a completed **George Biddle Kelley Education Foundation Scholarship Application** consisting of:

- An application cover sheet
- Completed short answer questions
- 400-500 word typed essay – Please follow the included essay guidelines
- Official school transcript in a sealed envelope
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation

Finalists for the scholarship will be contacted by the Chair of the Scholarship Committee to participate in an interview.

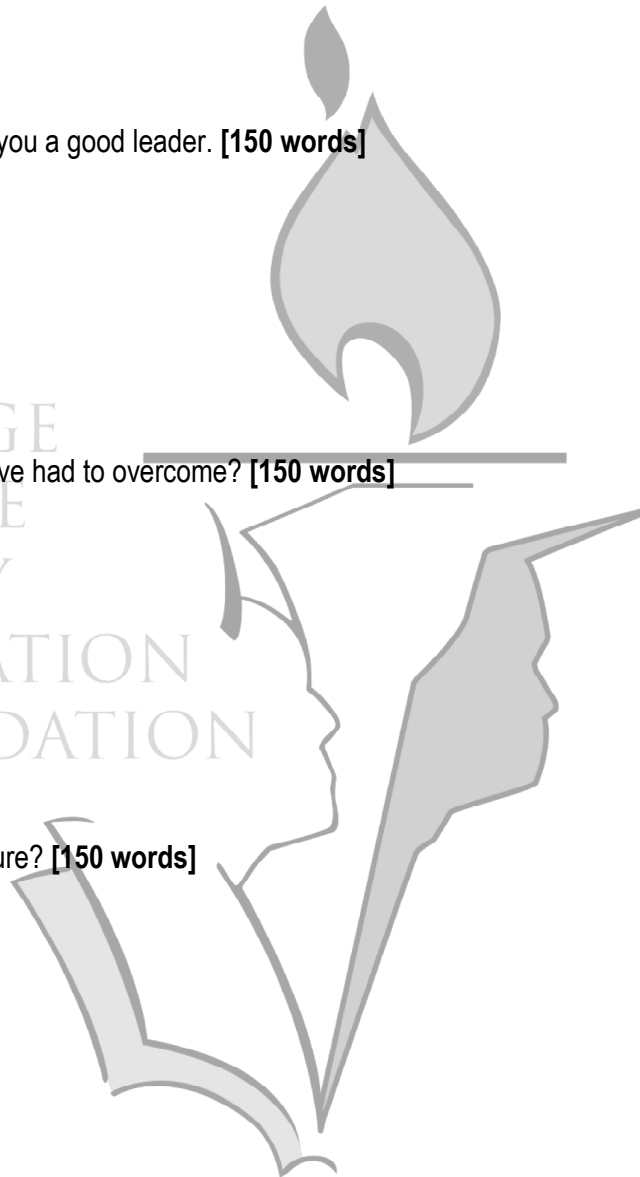

An important criterion for selecting the scholarship recipient is your potential to contribute back to your community. To assist the selection committee, please outline how you will contribute to your community during, and after your collegiate experience. In your essay clearly define the community you are coming from, what you consider to be its greatest needs and present your plan for providing these needs. Please use the space provided on the next page to write your essay.

The following are guidelines to assist you with developing your essay. Please follow the guidelines as written.

- The essay should be 400-500 words typed. Essays will not be returned.
- Your essay should focus on your own view of the status of your community and must describe what role you will play in its development.
- Your essay will be judged on:
 - a. **Creative content** – Did the applicant utilize a unique perspective or point of view?
 - b. **Idea Development & Focus** – Was the idea developed to its fullest extent? Was the essay coherent and rational? Did the applicant remain focused?
 - c. **Writing Style** – Includes format, spelling, punctuation, grammatical and typographical errors. Any grammatical or spelling errors will dramatically reduce your score.
